The 2019 is the third year we support and engage with the groups of street children. We have been engaging and being more familiar with the children, their family and complexity of their problems. During the mentoring process on the street children, we realize that all their problems come from the family. The street children usually come from poor families or troubled families. Since all of our mentoring activities for street children is not effective enough, we need to go to the family assistance toward the empowerment activities for groups of women.

Last year in 2018 we planned to assist elderly groups especially the women through various activities. In 2019, the activities of mentoring children and their families, especially the women are provided in an integrated ways. At Bong Suwung, the children are accompanied to develop their characters through various skills while the women are trained to develop their sewing skills. At *Perkampunagn Sosial Pingit*, children are accompanied to study while their homeless families are accommodated and accompanied to start the new job. While the activities in Prambanan have been a little bit different, we have just started again activities for children after 6 months stopped. We plan to create mentoring activities for

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parents of these children so that their poverty condition does not happen repeatedly from generation to generation. We want to continue with these activities in the year of 2020.

The struggle that we experienced in 2018 about the young adult woman in Bong Suwung has been still happening in the year 2019. This year we invited one young adult woman to help out in SPM Realino and gave her a pocket money. It turned out to be very helpful to her family. Her mother who has previously been sex workers begun to reduce her activity as a sex worker. Nowadays, there are still some teenager who need some jobs. We keep thinking about the work we can give to improve their life and the need of their family.

We are very grateful because we all have all the activities that can be performed because of the help of SKPI. We are grateful for the funds we received. To continue all the activities that we have done so far, we still need the help. Therefore, through this proposal, we ask the funds from SKPI so that we can continue to accompany the children of the street and their families.

II. Project

1. Organization

The Realino Foundation has two main activities. Firstly, the Educational scholarship is for the poor children. Secondly, the activities of empowerment and mentoring for the poor are both children and their families. We propose this proposal for the social empowerment and mentoring activities of children and their families.

The main goal of this activity is mentoring for the children and women empowerment. It is because some children work in the street because of some factors. Firstly, they come from the poor family, so they have to work for life. Secondly, there has serious problem in the family and the children decided to go outside their home. Thirdly, the presence of social environment influencing them to be free and do not tie to specific rules. Furthermore, most of factors of the street children are from their family.

During this time we accompany the children in a variety of skill activities to cultivate positive character in themselves. We also accompany groups of women through their skills so that they grow and have the ability. In the end, it can be used to work and earn additional income. We want to continue this activity as it has been positively influencing the children and groups of women.



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Nevertheless, we will develop the empowerment activities that we have provided and spread our services. The strategy we will perform to expand our network is as follows:

- We will build the network with wider variety of communities specifically to the young people (university students). They could be involved in mentoring children. This method not only gives children a positive effect but also develops young people to care for others.
- We create activity of the women empowerment more effective. During this time, the activity is the terms of the making accessories and sewing some craft. Their products have been already on sale and it give additional income to them. The developing process that is needed is to look for the regular marketing transaction.

2. Description of the project

In this project we will continue the activities that we have worked with some development process. These activities are the mentoring of street children and the empowerment of women in Bong Suwung, mentoring street children in *Perkampungan Sosial Pingit*, mentoring children and empowering women in Prambanan.

There are two categories of street children that we have assisted. 1). the children living in the street with their family. They accommodate in *Perkampungan Sosial Pingit*. 2). the children who are going to school and working in the street after going back from school, such as, selling snack, being beggar, and busking.

- **Bong Suwung Project**

We will continue and maintain the activities that have been running through mentoring the children and empowering the women. There have some university students who are involved in the children's mentoring. The activities which include many volunteers and mentors will create many skill programs that make the children not to feel bored. The children are also familiar with alternate mentors so they do not need to adapt when they are present.

In 2019, we planned to have various activities. In fact that the groups of women are more interested in the sewing.



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The empowerment activities through this skill will be continued and we keep thinking and organizing the way how to market their products. So far, we sell their products through online media and exhibitions.

- **Prambanan Project**

We have started our activities with the children in Prambanan and we are very grateful to be able to start again. We will continue the activities by emphasizing character education through various games and skills. We will also involve university students to accompany the children. The special agenda that we have in Prambanan is also to promote inter-religious cooperation.

The presence of awareness that the children's problem come from their family bring me to empower and assist their family specifically the women. We will train them by sewing activity. There has already been present trainer from the family whom their children are mentored by Realino.

- ***Perkampungan Sosial Pingit Project***

We concern on mentoring the street children in *Perkampungan Sosial Pingit*. Nowadays, *Perkampungan Sosial Pingit* has been providing a very intensive mentoring. It is held twice in a week. The priority of mentoring is to help children learn various lessons and complete their homework from school because no one can teach and help them at home. They need peer friends to study together. However, they do not have any money to call private tutors because the cost is quite expensive. Through the activities at *Perkampungan Sosial Pingit*, these street children are very helpful. Everything they don't understand at school could be asked to the mentors accompanying them. The risk that may happen toward this program is:

- the main problem we face during this program is the persistence and endurance in the whole activity of the street children. They are accustomed to getting money easily on the streets. Thus, passing through the process without getting money is not easy to be accomplished.



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3. Purpose and Aim

The main purpose of this proposal is to provide assistance to the street children and the program of women empowerment. The children are the most vulnerable groups in society. Through this activity, we expect to be able to give them the opportunity to grow and develop as other children. They can have good figures, much attention and love from the mentors.

The aim of empowerment activities for women is to develop their skills. Then, they can have the opportunity to grow their personality and ability as the women have the most important role to the children's education. Furthermore, they are expected to perform their role better than before.

Here are the following target of this project:

- Bong Suwung:
 - a. The children activity are followed by 25 children living near by railway of train station.
 - b. The women empowerment activity is followed by 7-10 women whom are the parents of some children that we accompany and mentor. They work as prostitute, scavenger and seller of small shop.
- Prambanan
 - a. There are 35-40 joining in our programs. They are the street children or the children whom their parents work on the street.
 - b. There are 5-10 women joining in empowerment activity. They work on the street.
- Perkampungan Sosial Pingit
There are 30-40 poor children joining in this program

4. Planning

The schedules for all activities are as follows:

- Bong Suwung
 - a. The children activity is held every Saturday at 01.00 p.m to 03.00 p.m in Bong Suwung arena



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- b. The women empowerment activity is held three times in a week, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Saturday from 02.00 p.m to 05.00 p.m in SPM Realino ballroom
- Prambanan
 - a. The children activity in Prambanan is held once in a month. It will be in the second week on Thursday at 02.00 p.m to 04.00 p.m in the ballroom of Prambanan district.
 - b. The women empowerment activity will be started on January 2020 through the sewing activity. It will be held once in a week on Wednesday at 02.00 p.m to 05.00 p.m.
 - Perkampungan Sosial Pingit

The children activity is held twice in a week on Monday and Thursday at 07.00 p.m to 09.00 p.m.

5. Evaluation

Evaluation will be held in the fourth week every month. By having evaluation regularly we will discuss the significant things happening. If we find some negative problems and some challenges, we will directly attempt to find the solution and solve it.
